Prerequisites for receiving the First Communion:

For your child to receive the First Communion he/she should:

- Be baptized. (If your child is not baptized yet, please contact immediately the Office of Religious Education)
- Provide a copy of the Birth and Baptism certificates to the Religious Education Office.
- Has had faithful attendance (no more than 4 absences in a year).
- Be in or beyond his/her second year of Religious Education. (First Communion is a two consecutive year program starting with children at 1st grade).
- The child must be well-prepared. The child must want to receive the Sacraments.
- In addition, students should have at least a knowledge of:
 - The Holy Mass
 - o Prayers: Make the Sign of the Cross. How to pray Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, Creed.
 - Sacraments.
 - Commandments.
 - Understands that sin is a grave matter. Understand the difference between a serious and less serious offense
 - Eucharist. Believes the Eucharist is the Body and Blood of Jesus. Has a desire to receive the Eucharist
 - Before First Reconciliation the student will need to be able to pray Act of Contrition and do an examination of conscience

Guidelines for the Reception of First Communion:

In order to better prepare your child, we need your collaboration by adhering to the following guidelines:

- ✓ **MASS ATTENDANCE**: Students must come to weekly Mass as part of their preparation for First Communion. In fact, the most important part of your children/youth preparation is weekly participation in Sunday Mass.
- ✓ **BAPTISM:** Children should be baptized before receiving First Communion.
- ✓ **CLASS ATTENDANCE**: Attendance to class is of extreme importance. No more than 4 excused attendances will be allowed for the child to do First Communion. Should the number of absences be exceeded, the pastor will have to consider having the child repeat the grade the following year. We must receive a note from you to report illness absences at dcabrera@sainttimothycatholic.org and your child must complete any assignments that were missed at class.
- ✓ PARENT PARTICIPATION: Parents are the first educators in their child's faith. Children are not only formed in the religious education programs, but foremost in their homes by their families. Parents should help students to know the sacraments. commandments, and basic prayers (The

Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary, Glory, and Act of Contrition) and play an active role in their faith formation.

- ✓ **MEETINGS**: Parents must attend all the meetings for the First Communion
- ✓ **RETREAT**: We will have a First Communion retreat. The retreat is mandatory for all students.
- ✓ **RECONCILIATION**: Children and parents must attend the Reconciliation Service.
- ✓ **REHEARSAL:** Children and parents must attend the First Communion rehearsal.
- ✓ **TUITION:** The registration payment should be completed by *February 16th, 2019* (checks can be made payable to St. Timothy Catholic Church). If the fee is a financial hardship, please contact the Religious Education Office. No child will be kept from a Sacrament because of financial reasons. Please contact the Religious Education Office for any problem related with payment the tuition.

- ✓ Provide a copy of the Birth Certificate and Baptism Certificate.
- ✓ Registration and retreat payments.

First Holy Communion Mass Instructions:

- ✓ There are six (6) different First Communion ceremonies.
- ✓ Students MUST ONLY attend the First Communion Ceremony of their own catechist.
- ✓ Students cannot attend the First Communion Ceremony of another classroom.
- ✓ At each First Communion ceremony, there are assigned seats for students
- ✓ Parents and family will be seated at the ceremony according to their order of arrival.
- ✓ Please arrive at least half hour before the Mass start.
- ✓ We will meet in the Church.

Note: Each student should bring two (2) WHITE roses for the Communion Mass. A white rose will be carried in the procession by every kid. (If parents can donate white roses for the mass, please contact Dennys Cabrera at dcabrera@sainttimothycatholic.org. Thanks for your generosity.

DRESS CODE FOR FIRST COMMUNION

For Boys:

Please use the following guidelines when choosing your child's attire. You can select <u>any of the two</u> options:

BOYS Option 1: White shirt and black or blue navy pants. (no jacket)

GIRLS DRESS CODE FOR FIRST COMMUNION

FIRST COMM	IUNION DRESS:
COLOR	 Pure White First Communion Dress. (NO Beige, ivory, or any other color than white color). White dress, is a symbol of purity and a reminder of the Baptism
LENGTH:	 A First Communion Dress should always fall below the knee. The length of the dresses of first communion will vary from just below the knee, to the length of half of the calf, and the length of the floor (touching the ankle). If you are opting for a long dress, keep in mind that you should choose a suitable length that does not touch or drag across the floor.
SLEEVE:	 Shoulders should be covered. Short sleeve and long sleeve dresses are traditional styles and do not require a cover up. No spaghetti straps or sleeveless dresses. (Shoulders should be covered during the First Communion ceremony and if that is the case, you can purchase a shawl, jacket or cape to be worn during the ceremony)
MATERIAL:	 keep in mind that if your child has sensitive skin, some sheer organza tops or sleeves can feel "itchy". So, it is important to try on the dress to see how it feels.
SHOES:	 White shoes. Low-heeled dress shoes. No high heels. Open or close toe shoes are fine.
SOCKS:	White ankle socks, tights or nude color hose.
TIARA:	 Girls can choose flowers or ribbons tiara (simple headpiece). No large tiaras or bridal headpieces No crowns.
ROSARY:	White Rosary.
GLOVES:	No gloves
PRAYER BOOK:	No prayer books.
SWEATER, PURSE	No sweater or purse.

Nice for pictures, but not for Mass:

- Gloves: White gloves can be wearing for pictures but must be removed before entering the Communion line. It is not permitted to pick up the host or hold the cup wearing gloves.
- Prayer book: It's great to has prayer book for pictures, but PLEASE DO NOT BRING IT TO THE FIRST COMMUNION MASS.
- Sweater, purse: if your child brings a shawl, a sweater, or a purse, we ask you to hold on to them in your pew.

Reserved Seat

- There will be reserved/ assigned seating ONLY for students.
- All other seating is on first come/first served basis.
- The arrival time is ½ hour before Mass. (Half an hour before Mass)

Recommended Dress Code

For Ladies:

- Attire suitable for Mass. Dresses and shirts should not be revealing or inappropriate in any way.
- Nice dress, skirt, or pants for ladies. (Skirt/dress at least one inch BELOW the knee)
- NO: spaghetti strap tops, bare midriffs, short skirts, gym shoes, jeans, or shorts.
- Dress shoes.

For Gentleman:

- Suit or nice slacks for men, dress shirt long sleeve with a tie.
- NO: jeans or gym shoes.
- Dress shoes.
- A nice sweater, collared shirt or suit jacket is appropriate on top.
- A suit and tie are acceptable, but not necessary.
- No hats should be worn in the church.
