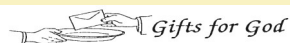

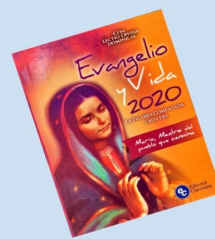

Registration will take place from July 21st, 2020 until August 26th, 2020.

COVID-19 Updates

Welcome to our Religious Education Program. We are planning for classes to begin in **September 2020**.

Due to the pandemic, we plan for a few scenarios that include virtual classes, traditional classes, or a mixed model. The most probable scenario to follow is to have virtual classes from September to December and reevaluate the situation in January. The final decision will be taken at the end of the Summer to make a prudent decision. We will comply with all health recommendations in the state of Florida, the Archbishop's guidelines, and the CDC norms for the safety of all our students and families. This situation may involve a limited class size, so we encourage you to register as soon as possible.

Class Sessions and Times

You may select to attend classes on **Saturdays or Wednesdays**.

- **Saturdays:** From 10:00 am to 11:30 am. For all students.
- ***Wednesdays:** from 4:30 pm to 6:00 pm. For pre-communion, communion, and post-communion students.
- **Wednesdays:** from 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm. For Pre-Confirmation and Confirmation students only.

*NOTE: Due to the coronavirus, classes could take place on Wednesdays from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm instead of 4:30 pm to 6:00 pm. We are going to reevaluate the situation at the end of the Summer to see if we can open classes on Wednesdays according to last years' schedule.

Registration Dates and Procedure (Every year is required to complete a registration form per student.)

- ✓ Registration will take place from **July 21st, 2020 until August 26th, 2020**. Registration will be processed first come/ first serve order. Space is limited. If you register your child later than August 26th, 2020, classes may be closed. We will try our best to accommodate your choice, but we recommend following the registration schedule.
- ✓ 2020-2021 Registration Process will be mainly online. Registration forms for Religious Education and all pertinent documents will need to be submitted at dcabrera@sainttimothycatholic.org. (In person registration will be by appointment only)
- ✓ Payment for Religious Education classes will be completed by mail.
- ✓ Two consecutive years of preparation are required for the reception of the sacraments.

DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT AT REGISTRATION TIME FOR **ALL new and returning STUDENTS**:

- ✓ **For Baptism:** Copy of Birth Certificate.
- ✓ **For Communion:** Copy of Birth and Baptist certificates.
- ✓ **For Confirmation:** Copy of Birth, Baptist, and Communion certificates
- ✓ **For all students:** Complete the Registration Form (one per child).
- ✓ **For all students:** Complete the Contribution Form and complete the payment by mail.
- ✓ **Transfer students:** Transfer students must bring a letter from their former parish stating years attended and levels completed.

Note: INCOMPLETE REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED. PLEASE SUBMIT ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS AND PAYMENTS.

Registration Tuition:

- ✓ Every year is required to pay a registration form per student. No student will be denied acceptance into the program because of financial issues. Arrangements can be made for alternate payment plans. Please contact Mrs. Dennys Cabrera
- ✓ Payments for Religious Education classes will be completed via **mail**. Please send a check with the tuition amount to the **Religious Education Program at St Timothy Catholic Church**. Address: 5400 SW 102nd Ave, Miami, FL 33165, USA
- ✓ Send by mail checks payable to **St Timothy Catholic Church**. **Be sure filling out the line that says "Memo". Write the name of the student, the day of the Religious Education class, and the word "CCD" in the Memo area. Also, include your phone number.**

GENERAL TUITION:

- Registration ONE CHILD: \$100 per student/yearly
- Registration TWO SIBLINGS: \$170 student & sibling/yearly.
- Registration THREE SIBLINGS: \$ 200 student & siblings /yearly.

ADDITIONAL FEES PER STUDENT: (only for 2nd preparation year)

- \$ 20/per student → Only if the student is preparing for First Communion in 2021- 2nd preparation year.
- \$ 40/per student → Only if the student is preparing for Confirmation in 2021- 2nd preparation year.
- \$ 25/per student → For Confirmation Gown (Only if the student is preparing for Confirmation in 2021- 2nd preparation year.)

Class of 2020

A year for the history books

MIAMI | Prospects for the class of 2020 looked bleak in mid-March, when in-person classes were canceled. As the coronavirus quarantine stretched past April and into May, the bleakness solidified: no pens, no class trips, no walk across the stage in cap and gown to receive a diploma.

The world was living through unprecedented times, and students and teachers were forced to adapt practically overnight: teaching and learning through Zoom and other videoconferencing platforms; getting together with friends only through screens.

The teenagers adapted better to the new mode of learning. Parents with young children, and their teachers, faced a tougher time getting the youngsters to stay on task and learn their lessons without the teacher's personal presence. Nothing in collective memory had prepared anyone for such a moment. The class of 2020 — both eighth graders in parochial schools and seniors in high schools — would go down in history.

And indeed, they did. But not for what they missed. The pandemic underscored a wave of creativity in archdiocesan teachers and administrators, a vital display of imagination and affection that transcended the physical distancing — and, ironically, made graduation even more memorable for the class of 2020.

Not for them a long, formal ceremony with keynote speakers whose names and words would be forgotten in a week. Not for them just one ceremony, in fact, but a series of many colorful celebrations.

Nearly all the schools held drive-by events — the "new normal" equivalent of a party — where parents and students, their cars festooned with balloons, posters and banners, passed through a phalanx of mask-wearing teachers handing out gifts.

Some teachers and administrators drove to their students' homes to drop off love signs exhorting the class of 2020, plus the traditional graduation regalia, yearbooks and other memorabilia.

The Immaculate Heart of Mary Sisters who administer Our Lady of Lourdes Academy announced

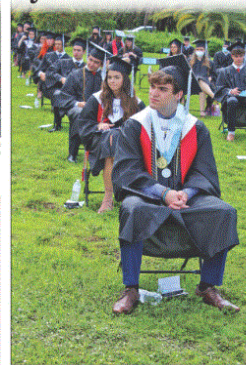
